

2023 Country Districts IPT Team Selection Criteria

Minimum Requirements

- Must be NCGU affiliated golfer in good standing with club and union.
- Must be 16 years or older prior to start of Country Districts IPT.
- A player must log a minimum of **10 counting** rounds to be eligible for selection.

Ranking Break down

- Player position will be calculated by obtaining an average differential (Diff) of his best calculated rounds.
- The Diff is calculated as: Gross score – Course Rating +/- PCC (Playing course condition)
- Ranking season **after conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2022** and concludes **on the conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2023.**
- Team announcement: **Week after conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2023.**

Counting Rounds

- All NCGU sanctioned Club Opens
- At least 1 of NCGU Official OOM Tournaments
 - Karoo Open
 - Magersfontein Open
 - Van Druten Open
 - NC Championship
 - NC Amateur and Mid-Amateur Open
- All GolfRSA National Ranking tournaments (Excludes Senior National Ranking Tournaments and Mid-Amateur Tournaments)

- The 6 top ranked players on the Countries OOM on the 31st of March 2023.
- Country Districts Team Selection Committee will select an additional 2 players from the ranking taking the following into consideration:
 - Position on ranking log.
 - GolfRSA Transformation Targets
 - Team Requirement and Structure
