- Must be NCGU affiliated golfer in good standing with club and union.
- Must be 16 years or older prior to start of Country Districts IPT.
- A player must log a minimum of 10 counting rounds to be eligible for selection.

Ranking Break down

- Player position will be calculated by obtaining an average differential (Diff) of his best calculated rounds.
- The Diff is calculated as: Gross score Course Rating +/- PCC (Playing course condition)
- Ranking season after conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2022 and concludes on the conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2023.
- Team announcement: Week after conclusion of NC Amateur & Mid-Amateur Open 2023.
